The City of Des Plaines Police Pension Board ("Board") is charged with administering and managing the Des Plaines Police Pension Fund for the benefit of its members and certain of their dependents, in accordance with Article 3 of the Illinois Pension Code ("Pension Code"). 40 ILCS 5/3-100 et seq. The Board is comprised of five members, elected and/or appointed as provided in the Pension Code. The address for the Board is: 1420 Miner St., Des Plaines, Illinois 60016.

- Board resolutions
- Administrative rules and procedures
- Investment policy
- Contracts
- Monthly financial reports

- Annual financial and actuarial reports
- Bills or invoices received and issued by the Board

Note: Some parts of public records maintained by the Board may be exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act.
